If the file is incomplete, the Prosecutor should return the file to the CFNIS for further investigation or a recommendation that charges do not proceed. This form should be completed by the Prosecutor within 14 days if all the proposed charges may be tried by Summary Trial, including electable offences, and within 30 days if any charges would result in an automatic court martial for the accused.
